TUBERCULIN SKIN TEST

Please come to the Employee Health Office on Mon., Tues., Wed. or Fri. (see office hours below) to have your tuberculin skin test done. You will be asked to return in two-three days to have the test read. Tests will not be given on Thursday because the Health Office is closed on Saturday and Sunday.

RUBELLA/RUBEOLA (Measles)/MUMPS

Please provide a record of **MMR** (Measles, Mumps, Rubella) vaccinations. Two MMR vaccinations are required. The first one must have been after the first birthday. If you do not have records, you may be asked to have a blood test to check for immunity.

VARICELLA (Chickenpox)

You will be asked if you have had chickenpox. If not, or if you are not certain, you may be asked to have a blood test to check for immunity. If you have had the varicella vaccinations, please provide those records.

WHERE TO ACQUIRE YOUR IMMUNIZATION RECORD

If you do not have your immunization records, you may be able to obtain the above information from your physician, your employer (or previous employer), from a school or college/university you have attended or are presently attending.

For Lincoln Public School students the **StudentVUE Account Access** is available for printing immunization records. Visit online at your school website. Select Essentials, then Parent/StudentVUE login and health. (<https://synergyvue.lps.org/>)

Also visit the **Nebraska State Immunization Information System, known as NESIIS. Visit them online to print your immunization record.** <http://dhhs.ne.gov>



If these options are not available, you will be asked to have a blood test through Bryan Medical Center Employee Health Services. You may have this done at the same time that you have your tuberculin skin test done.

Youth volunteers may obtain a vaccination if needed, from their physician or the Lincoln Lancaster County Health Department.
